To enter Canadian members should visit: <u>IBEW Canada Photo Contest</u> to register. There is a five (5) photo limit, and a copy of the *Photo Contest Rules/Guidelines* has been attached for your referral and should be reviewed before submissions are placed.

Up to ten (10) finalists will be selected for final judging by a diverse panel of judges who will evaluate the submissions based on creativity, relevance to the theme, and visual impact.

The finalists and winners will be featured on the IBEW Canada website and on all our social media platforms. The deadline for submissions is <u>Tuesday, March 05, 2024 at 5:00 PM PST</u>.

Photo Contest Rules

- 1. The contest is open to active or retired IBEW Canada members only. The person submitting the photo must be the person who took the photograph. Members may enter up to five photos each.
- 2. International officers and staff are not eligible.
- 3. Photos can be submitted as digital files of at least 300 dpi, measuring 1,200 by 1,800 pixels at minimum, in color or black and white.
- 4. All submissions become property of the IBEW Canada. Ensure the Sister has given her permission for this photo to be entered in this contest and may be used again in the future.
- 5. Photo entries must have a "Women in IBEW Canada" theme of some sort, with IBEW members at work, engaged in a union-related activity or featuring subjects conveying images of the electrical industry or the union.
- 6. Ensure you have permission to take photos at the workplace. Ensure your have the Sister's permission to take the photos of her and submit it to this contest to be featured on social media.

- 7. If members are featured in the photo, they should be identified. If large groups are pictured, the name of the group or the purpose of the gathering (e.g., a safety committee, a linemen's rodeo, a union meeting) can be submitted in place of individual names.
- 8. Photos previously published in IBEW publications or on the website are not eligible for submission.
- Entries must be submitted electronically via the Photo Contest link <u>here</u>. Please contact the First District IBEW Canada at <u>IVPD 01@IBEW.org</u> or 905-564-5441 with additional questions.
- 10.Up to 10 finalists will be selected and posted on <u>ibewcanada.ca</u> for final judging by a diverse panel of judges. The winners will be featured on <u>ibewcanada.ca</u> and all IBEW Canada Social Media Platforms on Friday March 08, 2024.

Photo Guidelines

Here are some guidelines that will help ensure that the photos you send in for the contest look as good to the rest of the world as they do to you:

- Pay close attention to pixel width and resolution. Generally, we need at least 300 dpi, measuring 1,200 by 1,800 pixels at minimum. Most computer programs have a "Properties" tab you can use to check pixel width and file size.
- Another good indication of image quality is file size. Typically, the file size should be listed in megabytes (MB). A file size listed in kilobytes (kb) is too small.
- Always err on the side of uploading a larger photo.
- Cameras also have adjustable settings for photo resolution. For print quality, camera settings should be set to an image size of 5 megapixels or higher. If you're unsure about the settings, a good rule of thumb is to set the camera to the highest quality setting it allows.
- Cellphone photos can be acceptable. Newer-model smartphones usually produce files that are high enough in resolution.
